WeHealth by Servier and UCSF form partnership to identify most promising e-health startups

Paris, France, San Francisco, United States, April 12, 2018 – WeHealth by Servier, Servier Group’s e-health division, and the Center for Digital Health Innovation (CDHI) at University of California, San Francisco (UCSF) announced today a partnership agreement to define the new market paradigm of digital therapeutics and to create clinical decision support tools by incentivizing early stage health technology developers to create commercial solutions.

Building on a common vision in the field of digital health, WeHealth by Servier and CDHI’s SmarterHealth initiative have joined forces to identify leading startups with solutions targeting the point of care in the areas of cardiovascular health, diabetes, cancer, neuropsychiatric, and immune-inflammatory diseases. The ultimate objective for the collaboration is to accelerate the development and dissemination of these digital solutions into the healthcare marketplace.

“This partnership is a tremendous opportunity for Servier to participate in one of the world’s largest innovation ecosystems,” said Dr. David Guez, Director of WeHealth by Servier. *“It is part of our open approach to innovation designed to offer novel digital solutions to patients and healthcare providers.”*

SmarterHealth leverages advanced analytics and computational capabilities to create solutions for patients and providers at the point of care. The program has the ability to achieve commercial scale through partnership co-development, and this could help to transform the way care is delivered at UCSF and around the world.

“Much of the early stage innovation around clinical decision support and digital therapeutics is missing the critical medical context and, along with it, the deep insights about how the technology might actually work in the clinic that only those with clinical expertise can provide,” said Dr. Michael Blum, UCSF Health Chief Digital Transformation Officer, Associate Vice Chancellor, and Executive Director of the UCSF Center for Digital Health Innovation. *“By combining the competencies of SmarterHealth and WeHealth by Servier we hope to fill the gap in clinical knowledge and thereby accelerate the development of early stage solutions.”*

The SmarterHealth platform offers the opportunity to create a fuller picture of the myriad of factors that contribute to health and disease at the individual level. This could help to tailor and optimize treatments for patients, based on their needs and experiences, and ensure that they receive care that is truly valuable to them.

“For a variety of reasons, including the need to protect patient privacy and security, the healthcare sector has proceeded cautiously in integrating artificial intelligence and machine learning,” said





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Rachael Callcut, MD, associate professor of surgery at UCSF and Program Director of SmarterHealth. “New answers for complex and costly healthcare problems may come from the integration of these tools, provided it is done in a way that protects and serves the interests of our patients.”
